

DOG OBEDIENCE REGATTA

By mutual agreement between the SDAS & the Isle of Man Dog Club, a limited number of car passes will be issued, on request, from the Club. Only cars* will be permitted on the Show Field and the gate opening and closing times must be strictly observed.

*Adapted vehicles/vans used to transport dogs will be permitted. Camper vans will not be allowed.

Class DO1 SPECIAL PRE- BEGINNER CLASS – Judge – June Iveagh

For dogs, handlers & owners eligible for a pre-beginners class at an open show.

- 1) Heel on lead – 25 points
 - 2) Recall to front and finish – 15 points
 - 3) 1/2 minute sit stay – 10 points
 - 4) 1 minute down stay – 20 points
- Total – 70 points**

Extra Commands will not be penalised except in the Stay exercises

Class DO2 SPECIAL BEGINNERS CLASS – Judge – Carol Lewin

For dogs, handlers & owners eligible for a beginners class at an open show.

- 1) Heel on lead – 20 points
 - 2) Recall to front and finish – 20 points
 - 3) Retrieve to front and finish – 20 points
 - 4) 1 minute sit stay – 20 points
 - 5) 1 minute down stay – 20 points
- Total – 100 points**

Extra commands will not be penalised except in the Stay exercises

Class DO3 SPECIAL NOVICE CLASS - Judge – Karen Westcott

For Dogs eligible for Kennel Club Novice Test

- 1) Heel on lead - 15pts
 - 2) Heel free - 20pts
 - 3) Recall to front and finish - 10pts
 - 4) Retrieve a dumb-bell - 15pts
 - 5) Sit stay one minute, handler in sight - 20pts
 - 6) Down stay two minutes, handler in sight - 20pts
- Total 100pts**

Extra commands will not be penalised except in the stay exercises

Class DO4 SPECIAL OPEN CLASS - Judge – Tracey McKinlay

- 1) Heel free, normal, slow and fast pace - 40pts

- 2) Send away, drop and recall - 40pts
 - 3) Retrieve judge's article - 30pts
 - 4) Two minute sit stay, out of sight - 20pts
 - 5) Three minute down stay, out of sight - 30pts
 - 6) Scent discrimination (handlers scent on judge's cloth) - 30pts **Total - 190pts**
- This will be judged as Kennel Club Class B and extra commands will be penalised.**
