Bye-laws: The following additions to the Bye-laws of the Society will apply to the Light Horse Classes only.

- No. 6 Changes to rider (with the exception of the Equitation/Handler classes) at the discretion of the Light Horse Committee. Children who have not attained their 3rd birthday by 1st January of the current year will not be permitted to ride.
- No. 7 All Light Horse Classes will be treated as "Extra Classes".
- No. 8 The age of the horse/pony is calculated from January 1st in the year of its birth.
- No. 9 Handlers of stallions or colts must be 14 years old or over.
- No. 10 All prize winners wishing to take part in the Grand Parade must be accompanied in the main ring by a competent adult handler.

No. 11 Riding Hats - Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet current Safety Standards **MUST** be worn by all Riders.

No.12 Any Exhibitor demonstrating abusive or aggressive behaviour towards stewards may be requested to withdraw from competition, and forfeit any prizes, at the discretion of the Protest Committee.

No. 13 All riders must be suitable mounted and may be asked to leave the ring at the judge's discretion if deemed not to be.

The judges reserve the right to eliminate any horse or pony entered with any discrepancy as to height or age or any other misrepresentation.

Please note: Once judging has started latecomers may be let into the class at the Judge's discretion only. Competitors must choose which class they enter if times clash.

period 1st May-30th April inclusive. Qualification is Pony/Rider Combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final. Ponies may compete in one section only.

Qualifies for: Four Double Clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is Pony/Rider Combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.
